

## Cookie Policy

This website uses Cookies, small text files that allow storing information about visitors' preferences to improve the site's functionalities, simplify navigation by automating procedures (e.g., website language login), and for site usage analysis.

<b>PHPSESSID</b>	First part	Cookie generated by applications based on the PHP language. This is a general purpose identifier used to manage user session variables. It is normally a randomly generated number, how it is used can be specific to the site, but a good example is maintaining a logged-in status for a user between pages.	session
<b>cb-enabled</b>	First part	This cookie is associated with a free script that displays a cookie warning notice on a website. It is used to record when the user has dismissed the warning to prevent it from appearing again on subsequent visits.	1 year

## How to manage preferences and provide or revoke consent on this Website
